# **Updated 04 November 2022**

## I. Departments with farm cases since July 2022

14 departments currently have at least one restriction area due to an outbreak in poultry farms: Ain, Côtes-d'Armor, Dordogne, Ille-et-Vilaine, Indre, Loire-Atlantique, Loiret, Maine-et-Loire, Meuse, Morbihan, Sarthe, Deux-Sèvres, Somme, Vendée.

Concerning the departments of Meuse (55), Ille-et-Vilaine (35), Somme (80) and Morbihan (56), the DG for Food is in the process of finalising the study of the surveillance data in order to lift the restricted zones in the near future, which will allow these departments to regain their free status in the absence of a new outbreak.

### • Vendée (85): 2 additional outbreaks

31/10: confirmation of a 10th outbreak in Vendée (85) in a farm of 76,000 laying hens in the municipality of: MOREILLES

31/10: confirmation of an 11th outbreak in Vendée (85) in a farm of 9,000 turkeys in the municipality of: LA CHAPELLE AUX LYS

### Côtes-d'Armor (22): 1 additional outbreak

31/10: confirmation of a 2nd outbreak in Côtes-d'Armor (22) in a farm of 7,300 chickens in the municipality of: HILLION

#### Deux-Sèvres (79): 1 new outbreak

31/10: confirmation of an outbreak in Deux-Sèvres (79) in a farm of 8,600 ducks in the municipality of: LARGEASSE

#### Indre (36): 1 new outbreak

02/11: confirmation of an outbreak in Indre (36) in a farm of 26300 turkeys in the municipality of: ROUVRES LES BOIS

### Sanitary measures, zoning

As for all outbreaks, as soon as the suspicion was raised, sanitary management measures were triggered within the EU regulatory implemented zoning (3 km Protection Zone "ZP" and 10 km Surveillance Zone "ZS" around the farm): culling of poultry on affected farms (either as a preventive measure or at the latest the day after NRL confirmation), reinforcement of biosecurity measures, census of farms and ban on poultry movements.
