

Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) situation in France

Updated 16 of September 2024

I. Departments with outbreaks

Three departments currently have a restriction zone due to outbreaks: Ille-et-Vilaine, Morbihan and Finistère.

The three farms were not vaccinated against HPAI. All the animals in the outbreaks were eliminated. No outbreak in poultry has been confirmed since September, 3 2024.

Control measures within the zoning

As for all outbreaks, as soon as the suspicion was raised, control measures were triggered within the EU regulatory zoning (3 km Protection Zone "ZP" and 10 km Surveillance Zone "ZS" around the farm): culling of poultry on affected farms (at the latest the day after the national reference laboratory - NRL confirmation), reinforcement of biosecurity measures, census of farms and ban on poultry movements.

No other outbreak have been confirmed in poultry farming. These are isolated events.

The outbreak in Ille-et-Vilaine was infected by wildlife. The main hypothesis for the outbreak in Morbihan and Finistère is also contamination via wildlife.
