

## Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI)

situation in France

Updated 29 of November 2024

## I. Departments with outbreak

Three departments currently have a restriction zone due to outbreaks: Morbihan, Landes and Allier. All the animals in the outbreaks were eliminated.

## Control measures within the zoning

As for all outbreaks, as soon as the suspicion was raised, control measures were triggered within the EU regulatory zoning (3 km Protection Zone "ZP" and 10 km Surveillance Zone "ZS" around the farm): culling of poultry on affected farms (at the latest the day after the national reference laboratory - NRL confirmation), reinforcement of biosecurity measures, census of farms and ban on poultry movements.

The contamination hypothesis for these outbreaks is via wildlife.
